




#### Strategies for Improvement:

#### III. Sessions Conducted:



#### IV. Strategies for Improvement:



#### I. Introduction:


#### **ANNUAL REPORT (2019-2020)**

#### 2. MCQ-Based Discussions and Exam Preparations:

- After each theory class, multiple-choice question-based discussions were routinely conducted to reinforce learning.
- Previous year's question papers were discussed to familiarize students with the exam pattern.
- Alumni who had excelled in past exams were invited to guide the current interns, resulting in nine students clearing their exams.

#### 3. Individualized Doubt-Solving Sessions:

Faculty members from different speciality branches of dentistry were assigned for one-on-one doubt-solving sessions with students, ensuring personalized attention and academic support.
