

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



On Day 2 of the programme began shortly after lunch. The participants were briefed on the surgical principles of dental implants.


On Day 3, restorative aspects of dental implants were discussed.


Day 7 commenced with a talk on condylar fractures. Classification, indications and various treatment methods were discussed in detail.
