



Date: January 1, 2024


Venue: Mini Auditorium, Al Azhar Dental College, Thodupuzha

- 7. National Anthem: The program concluded with the national anthem.



# QUESTIONNAIRE TO ASSESS THE EFFECTIVENESS OF ANTI RAGGING VIDEOS

Data were collected through a structured questionnaire consisting of two parts: pre-video questions and post-video questions. The questionnaire was designed to assess participants' perceptions of anti-ragging initiatives, their understanding of ragging's consequences, willingness to intervene, and the impact of anti-ragging videos.

#### Procedure:

- Prior to video exposure, participants were asked a series of questions to gauge their baseline perceptions.
- Participants then viewed anti-ragging videos specifically created for the study.
- Following video exposure, participants responded to a set of questions aimed at evaluating the shift in their perceptions
  after watching the videos.

#### Survey Questions:

- Pre-Video Questions: Participants were queried about their awareness of ragging's consequences, confidence in reporting
  incidents, perception of ragging's impact on the learning environment, and views on whether ragging constitutes harassment
  and should be tolerated. They were also asked about their beliefs in the efficacy of anti-ragging initiatives.
- Post-Video Questions: Similar themes were covered in the post-video section, including improved understanding of ragging's harmful effects, willingness to intervene, influence of anti-ragging videos on their perspectives, readiness to handle ragging situations, and motivation to participate in anti-ragging efforts. The final question focused on the perceived effectiveness of the videos.





HAVE YOU BEEN PREVIOUSLY EXPOSED TO ANTI RAGGING ACTIVITIES?





# HOW EFFECTIVE DO YOU THINK THESE ANTI RAGGING VIDEOS ARE IN RAISING AWARENESS AND PROMOTING A SAFE ENVIRONMENT?



#### RESULT

The questionnaire aimed to assess the perceptions of student population regarding anti-ragging initiatives through a structured survey. The population consisted of individuals with a mean age of 22.95 years, ranging from 21 to 28 years. The gender distribution was 17.8% males and 82.2% females.

Prior to exposure to anti-ragging videos, participants were asked a series of questions. Concerning their awareness of the negative consequences of ragging, 30.1% strongly agreed and 58.9% agreed. In the context of reporting incidents of ragging, 23.3% were neutral, white 28.8% strongly agreed and 46.6% agreed. Regarding the creation of a hostile environment hindering learning due to ragging, 11% were neutral, 28.8% strongly agreed, and 49.3% agreed. The perception of ragging as a form of harassment not to be tolerated showed 16.4% neutral, 32.9% strongly agreed, and 46.6% agreed. Furthermore, respondents' attitudes toward the positive impact of anti-ragging initiatives revealed 13.7% neutral, 30.1% strongly agreed, and 47.9% agreed.

Following exposure to anti-ragging videos, participants' responses shifted. Their understanding of the harmful effects of ragging showed 30.1% strongly agreed and 64.4% agreed. The likelihood of intervening to discourage ragging was reflected in 13.7%

Principal Al-Azhar Dental College Thodupuzha - ASS Son VI 17.8% neutral, 23.3% strongly agreed, and 57.5% agreed. Summarry, me intuience of anni-ragging videos on their perspectives snowed 17.8% neutral, 23.3% strongly agreed, and 57.5% agreed.

Regarding preparedness to handle ragging situations, 16.4% were neutral and strongly agreed each, while 67.1% agreed. Motivation to participate in anti-ragging efforts yielded 57.5% agreed, 27.4% strongly agreed, and 15.1% neutral responses. The final inquiry evaluated the effectiveness of anti-ragging videos in raising awareness and promoting a safe environment. Responses indicated that 1.4% each found the videos very ineffective and ineffective, 13.7% held a neutral opinion, 26% deemed them very effective, and 57.5% perceived them as effective.

#### CONCLUSION

In conclusion, this exercise delved into the perceptions of a diverse population regarding anti-ragging initiatives, employing a comprehensive survey approach. The findings revealed that exposure to anti-ragging videos led to notable shifts in participants' attitudes and awareness levels. The majority of respondents demonstrated an increased understanding of the harmful effects of ragging, a greater likelihood to intervene and discourage such behaviour, and an enhanced readiness to address ragging situations.

Moreover, the study underscored the positive influence of anti-ragging videos on participants' perspectives and motivation to actively engage in anti-ragging efforts. The effectiveness of these videos in raising awareness and fostering a secure environment was evidenced by a significant percentage of participants perceiving them as effective or very effective.

This research contributes valuable insights into the potential impact of multimedia interventions in the realm of anti-ragging initiatives. The outcomes highlight the need for continued efforts to promote awareness, empowerment, and participation in combating ragging within educational settings. Ultimately, the study's results offer a foundation for refining anti-ragging strategies and advancing the creation of safer and more inclusive learning environments.


Winners Announcement: After a thorough evaluation of the submitted e-posters by a panel of judges, three outstanding entries were selected for recognition.


