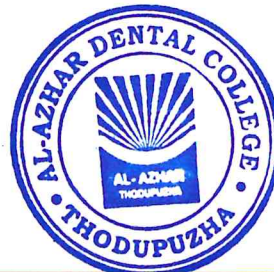
Objectives:
