NRI CELL POLICY

Introduction

The NRI Cell of Al-Azhar Dental College was established to facilitate and support students admitted under the NRI quota in accordance with the norms of regulatory authorities and Kerala University of Health Sciences.

The cell serves as a support and coordination body to assist students admitted under the NRI category in academic, administrative, and institutional matters during their course of study. Many students admitted under the NRI quota may be Indian nationals sponsored by Non-Resident Indians; however, the institution ensures that they receive appropriate academic guidance and equal opportunities in all institutional activities.

The NRI Cell functions to maintain transparency in the admission process and to ensure that students admitted under this category are able to integrate smoothly into the academic environment of the college.

OBJECTIVES

1. Admission Guidance

To provide guidance and assistance to students seeking admission under the NRI quota by explaining eligibility criteria, admission procedures, and required documentation as prescribed by regulatory authorities and Kerala University of Health Sciences.

2. Documentation Support

To assist students in submitting and verifying documents related to NRI sponsorship, passports, visa details (if applicable), and other relevant documents required for admission.

3. Compliance with Institutional Regulations

4. Student Welfare

5. Communication and Coordination

To act as a link between students, parents or sponsors, and the college administration regarding admission procedures, academic progress, and institutional policies.

6. Cultural and Social Integration

To encourage NRI quota students to actively participate in cultural, academic, and extracurricular activities organized by the institution.

7. Grievance Support

To provide a platform for students to communicate any issues or concerns and to ensure that such matters are addressed appropriately by the concerned authorities

POLICY GUIDELINES


1. Eligibility

Admission under the NRI quota shall be in accordance with the eligibility criteria and admission regulations prescribed by the Government, regulatory authorities, and Kerala University of Health Sciences.

2. NRI Sponsorship

Candidates admitted under the NRI quota must provide valid proof of NRI status or sponsorship by a Non-Resident Indian relative as required by regulatory authorities.

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2. Verification of Documents

To coordinate with the admission office in verifying the authenticity of documents related to NRI status or sponsorship.

3. Student Support and Guidance

To provide necessary guidance and support to NRI quota students regarding academic activities, institutional policies, and available facilities.

4. Coordination with Departments

To coordinate with academic departments and administrative offices to address issues or concerns raised by NRI quota students.

5. Monitoring Student Progress

To monitor the academic progress and general well-being of NRI quota students and provide support whenever necessary.

To maintain communication between students, parents/sponsors, and the college administration regarding academic matters or institutional requirements.

7. Grievance Handling


To receive and address grievances or concerns of NRI quota students and forward the issues to appropriate institutional authorities when necessary.


8. Encouraging Participation
